Summary

CROATIAN POLITICS IN RELATION TO THE SERBIAN PEOPLE DURING THE 20TH CENTURY ON THE TERRITORY OF TODAY'S CROATIA

We believe that the Serbs suffered during the rule of Franjo Tudjman and his successors. It is important to point out that attacks on the Serbs were also heard in the Croatian Parliament on October 4, 1990, at the time of the constitution of new Croatia, several months before the armed conflicts occurred. So, as a kind of conclusion, it could be said that if one environment, in this case Croatia, is deliberately and for a long time fed by such assessments, it is natural that it came to the conclusion that Serbs should be destroyed no matter what. Science abounds in numerous proofs of this claim. The historical events that took place from 1941 to 1945 and from 1991 to 1993 confirmed the assessments of P. Gavranic pronounced in 1985 in the "Political History of the Croatian People" (Politička povjest hrvatskog naroda). Both times when the Croats acquired "their independent states", as Gavranic predicted, the victims were Serbs. Hatred against them was expressed with a clear goal: to create an ethnically pure and a Croatian state as big as possible. They finally achieved this goal at the end of the 20th century, when they forcibly seceded from Yugoslavia, and without choosing the means, blackmail, threats, brutal war and finally open expulsion of the Serbian population, they achieved ethnically pure state they had desired for centuries. In achieving that goal, whose main strategist was the "father of the nation" Franjo Tudjman, the unity of the Croats seemed so convincing that the world accepted the fact that "Storm" (Oluja) and "Flash" (Bljesak), were defending Croatia's legitimate attitude towards the rebels, although in fact they were planned war operations that expelled Serbs from their private estates and from the territory from which they had lived for centuries.
