FROM PAST TO PRESENT ON DISCRIMINATION/NON-DISCRIMINATION IN PERFORMING ARCHIVAL ACTIVITIES

Abstract: In the paper, the author sets the goals of the work in the introductory remarks: to point out the basic knowledge from the past about discrimination, as well as the prohibition of discrimination in any segment of the actions of civil servants, even in the one related to the performance of archival activities. The following basic research methods will be applied: historical-legal method; analysis of text content; normative method. In the first part of the paper, attention is drawn to the abundance of facts from the past about discrimination. In the second part of the work, the author first states the provisions of the normative acts that determine the basis of archival activity: the Law on Culture, the Law on Archival Materials and Archival Activities and the Code of Conduct of Civil Servants. In the last part of the paper, the author believes that research should be carried out in the digitized material of the Niš Historical Archive, namely those segments that may refer to discrimination, in the original use of words or searching for descriptive content; perform a review and selection of all published texts in the magazine *Sandglass* (Peščanik) describing cases of inequality, equality, discrimination.
