**SKETCHES FROM THE ECONOMIC HISTORY OF THE CITY OF NIŠ  
AND NIŠ DISTRICT WITH A LIST OF MATERIALS FROM THE HISTORICAL  
ARCHIVES OF BELGRADE**

**Summary:** After a brief review of the basic data from the economic history of Niš, which were viewed in a wide time span from the Middle Ages to the Second World War, the paper published a list of archival materials kept in the Historical Archive of Belgrade (IAB), in the “Chamber of Commerce fund of Belgrade” (F. 509). It is about the documentation that was created in connection with the work of the Chamber of Commerce in the time from its creation in 1910 to the end of its work in 1948. The fund is unorganized, so it is not possible to make an accurate conclusion about the total amount of archival material, which consists of: registers, ledgers, minutes books, correspondence, lists, petitions, decisions, action files, etc. In the building, there are documents related to the former Niš region (the city of Niš, the city of Pirot, Nišavski srez, Caribrodski srez, etc.). This paper lists a part of the existing documents and their signatures, which refer to the city of Niš and the county of Niški, during the time of the Kingdom of Yugoslavia and the time immediately after the end of the Second World War. Since the economic history of the city of Niš and the region of Niš has not been sufficiently studied, these first-class sources containing financial data can be the subject of analyzes by economic historians, i.e., the listed archival material can contribute to the study of the economic and economic history of Niš and the region of Niš in the period 1930–1948. Therefore, the list of documents prepared in this paper aims to point out the existence of this archival material to researchers of the economic and economic history of Niš, so that it can be used in some subsequent research.
